

Privacy policy pursuant to Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) no. 679/2016

In accordance with the provisions of Art. 13 of European Regulation 679/2016, we hereby wish to inform you of the following:

Purpose of processing:

Your personal data, freely communicated and acquired by us by virtue of the activities performed by Lorandi Silos Srl, shall be processed lawfully and fairly for the following purposes:

- administrative-accounting purposes in managing the contractual and/or pre-contractual relationship;
- Other purposes are related to promotional and informative activities.

The data processed (which may be of a common, identifying, sensitive or judicial nature) is up to date, relevant, complete and not excessive with respect to the purposes listed above for which it is collected and subsequently processed.

Methods of processing:

Your data shall be processed as follows, with due regard for the necessary security measures and confidentiality: collection of data from the data subject, collection and registration for specific, explicit and legitimate purposes and use in other processing operations in a manner compatible with said purposes, processing using electronic and automated means (online data collection directly from the data subject).

Legal basis of processing:

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is your acceptance of the contract, proposal or offer submitted by us to you or vice versa. Further to your request for information or offers regarding our products or services.

Legitimate interests pursued by the Data Controller:

The legitimate interests pursued by the Data Controller in processing the data consist in fulfilling and honouring the contractual obligations entered into by the parties or compliance with their requests. Pursuant to Art. 6, the lawfulness of the processing is based on the consent manifestly expressed by the data subject and documented in writing.

Mandatory or optional nature of data provision and consequences of any refusal to respond:

Your provision of administrative accounting data is mandatory in order for the Data Controller to be able to provide the requested services. In the event of refusal, therefore, it shall be impossible to continue the relationship and for the Data Controller to fulfil its contractual obligations. The provision of data for advertising and informative purposes, on the other hand, is not mandatory and is provided on the basis of express consent.

Disclosure of data to third parties:

Your personal data shall be processed by the Data Controller, by its appointed Data Processors and by Persons authorised to process data. It may be disclosed to institutional bodies if requested by the latter.

Your data may be disclosed following inspections or audits (if requested) to all inspection bodies in charge of audits and inspections concerning compliance with legal requirements.

Your data may also be communicated to companies/professional firms that provide assistance, consulting services, or that collaborate with the Data Controller with regard to accounting, administrative, tax-related, legal, fiscal and financial matters, to public administrations for the fulfilment of institutional functions within the limits established by the law or regulations, and to third-party service providers to whom said data must be disclosed in order to provide the services covered by the contract. Your personal data shall not be diffused in any way.

Retention periods:

Your personal data shall be retained for no. 10 (ten) years, from the termination of the relationship or until the business purposes are achieved.

Existence of an automated decision-making process:

There is no automated decision-making process.

Intention of Data Controller:

The Data Controller shall not transfer your personal data to a third country or international organisation, except in the context of its business operations with subsidiaries.

Data Controller and Data Processor:

The Data Controller is Lorandi Silos Srl.

The data subject may exercise the rights reserved to them under Art. 15, the full text of which is provided below.

Art. 15 Regulation (EU) 679/2016 –Right of access to personal data and other rights –

The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the Data Controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning them exists, even if not yet recorded, and its communication in an intelligible form. The data subject has the right to receive information regarding the origin of the personal data; the purposes and methods of processing; the logic applied in the event processing is carried out with the aid of electronic means; the identification details of the Data Controller, of the Data Processor and of the designated representative pursuant to Art. 5, paragraph 2; the parties or categories of parties to whom personal data may be communicated, or who may become aware of such data, in their capacity as designated representative in the territory of the State, Data Processor or Person authorised to process data. The data subject has the right to obtain: the updating, rectification, or, when interested, integration of data; the erasure, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which the data was collected or subsequently processed. The data subject has the right to object in whole or in part: on legitimate grounds, the processing of data concerning them, even if pertinent to the purpose of collection; the processing of personal data concerning them, intended for the purposes of sending promotional materials and for direct selling, or to conduct market surveys or advertising campaigns. In particular, the data subject may, at any time, request from the Data Controller access to and rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing concerning the data subject, as well as the right to data portability. The data subject shall have the right to withdraw consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal, and the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
